



Local 53 was awarded over \$300,000 during the 2020 Covid Crisis. The membership voted to invest the money and create a Scholarship Fund with the interest earned for dependent children (defined as biological, step or legally adopted children living in the member's household or primarily supported by the member) of any Local 53 member in good standing. The deadline for this year's submission is **April 1, 2025.** 

Scholarships will be awarded based on the interest earned from our investments along with the number of applicants we receive each year. The scholarships will be given to any graduating senior that will be attending a 2- or 4-year college, trade school or an apprentice program. Current college students already enrolled along with Local 53 Apprentices are eligible to apply as well.

Scholarships will be announced and awarded after the April meeting. The payout will be in the fall once the students are enrolled and proof of enrollment is provided from the finical office. Please have proof of enrollment turned in by **September 1st**. Apprentices will be recognized and paid at another time to be announced.

An announcement of the number of scholarships given out and who the winners are will be announced during the April General Meeting and posted online each year. Every student that applies will be notified after the announcements are made.
